Admissions Policy

Faraday School seeks committed families and pupils who can contribute to and benefit from its high standard of education and care. Pupils are selected for admission to the school on the basis of the date when their child was first registered. Siblings will be given priority over this.

There are no entrance exams and the school does not seek an academically selected intake. Where appropriate and especially when admitting older children, testing will be used to provide information to assist in the assessment of a candidate's skill level. Parents(s) or guardian(s) of a candidate may be interviewed in addition to the candidate. In all cases the school retains the right to determine, at its sole discretion, whether or not to select a pupil for admission or to re-enrol a pupil. The head has ultimate authority and sole discretion in the whether or not to admit or re-enrol a pupil.

Parent(s) or guardian(s) of accepted candidates must sign a contract committing to the school's codes of conduct and ethos.
