



Stephenson School School Uniform Policy

The school endeavours to maintain a smart, user-friendly dress code which is affordable and sensible. We do ask parents to adhere to it. In particular please help us avoid any designer label fads and do keep to uniform where supplied.

***Stephenson School requires that pupils adhere to our dress code.
Where items are available through suppliers, school children must wear these.
All items must be clearly labelled with a sewn-in nametape.***

For boys:

Dark trousers (navy, black or grey)

School polo shirt and sweatshirt to be worn at all times

During summer months, boys may wear shorts (navy, grey, black)

Socks (navy, grey, black, red or white only)

Shoes (traditional shoes, plain navy, brown, black, red – no Ugg boots, boots, Geox etc). In the summer, children may wear sandals, but they should always wear socks for health and safety reasons.

For girls:

Dark trousers (blue, black or grey)

Dark skirt/pinafore dress (blue, black or grey)

School shirt and sweatshirt to be worn at all times

During summer months, girls may wear shorts or a checked red/white summer dress

Socks/tights (navy, grey, black, red or white only)

Shoes (traditional plain navy, brown, black, red – no Ugg boots, boots, Geox etc). In the summer, children may wear sandals, but they should always wear socks for health and safety reasons.

Footwear:

Pupils are not to wear trainers/Geox on a daily basis. **Pupils must be able to put on and take off their own shoes.** If necessary, this may mean pupils wearing shoes that fasten with Velcro or buckles. No laces in Reception/Year1 or 2 please.

Physical Education

Pupils will require separate clothes for PE:

White t-shirt and shorts

Red school sweatshirt

Blue school tracksuit bottoms

Plimsolls/trainers (white or black and *not* multicoloured, laced or flashing!)
