Founded in 2009, Faraday is a small but growing independent primary school in East London. The school's riverside location provides a magical environment and access to a stimulating, creative community that offers exciting learning opportunities for the pupils and staff.

The Head of Music teaches weekly lessons to all the classes, from Reception through to Year 6. They also lead a number of our music clubs, including the choir, and help to nurture the musical talent of all our pupils. They teach a challenging and engaging curriculum and have the support of SLT to be creative in their approach.

The role will also include coordinating whole school events, such as concerts and plays, and working together with the drama teacher, peripatetic teachers, and other colleagues. This role requires strong planning and organisation skills, as well as a collegiate, and confident approach. Experience in this area is essential for the role.

The successful candidate will be a confident and accomplished musician with a broad repertoire. Alongside their passion for the subject, they will have proven experience teaching primary-aged children and a desire to further develop the music department at Faraday.
